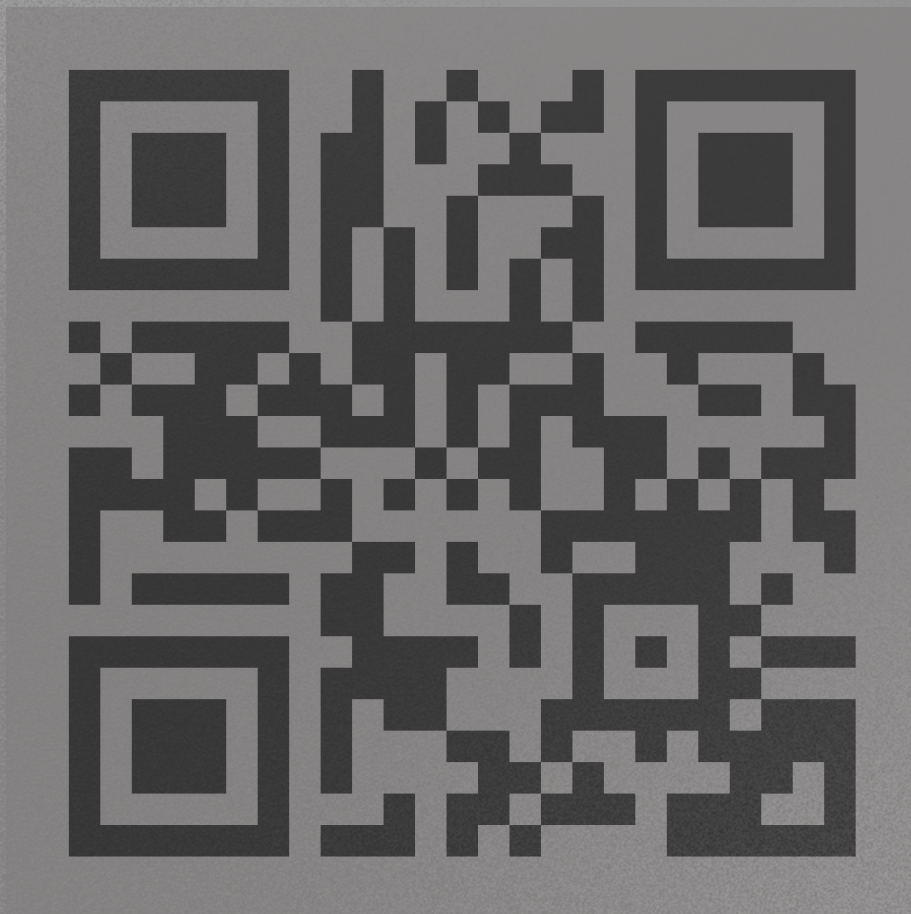
Together, let us embrace these forty days as a time of spiritual renewal, aligning ourselves with God's will for the conference and our individual lives.

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to produce abundant fruit in your life, displaying the character of Christ in all your interactions and endeavours (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Seek God's blessings and protection over your life, family, and ministry. Pray for His favour and grace to be evident in all that you do (Numbers 6:24-26)
