Why We Must Know God



What it Means to Know Someone

To know someone may mean the following :

1. To have developed a friendship with the person through meeting and spending time with them .
2. To have a clear perception of the facts and truths about a person through inquiry, observation or direct contact

Knowing someone is quite different from knowing about the person. Actually knowing seems to connote a need to have a personal experience rather than being detached from the facts. It requires an active immersion. A quest for deeper knowledge will require intimacy with the one we seek to know. Knowing someone involves knowing their thought patterns, knowing the trends of predictable behaviour, understanding trigger points for certain courses of action, knowing their likes and dislikes, and fully grasping the background codes that drive and influence them.

These facts will be instrumental in developing a fruitful relationship with the one we seek to know, being fully equipped to harness and leverage the advantages the relationship has for our progress. Fortunately for us, the One we seek to know, God, has all these signified and documented in His book called the "Living Word". The Word that bears all the characteristics of a living being, and can be fully activated by the Holy Spirit, its divine

author!

Why Must we Know God

- *The Knowledge of the Holy (God) is Understanding.*

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. Proverbs 9:10 KJV .

Knowing and fearing God is the path to wisdom and understanding. In these times where there is uncertainty and volatility in the world, we need God's wisdom and spiritual understating to proceed and succeed. We can only get this through the fear of God and the knowledge of God

And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is treasure. Isaiah 33:6 KJV

We shall no more be tossed to and fro by any wind of doctrine or by any suggestions that lead to naught. We shall experience Stability because we chose the path of God's wisdom. W4KG!

- *To build Strong Faith in God.*

There are limitless possibilities in God. He is the all-powerful and all-knowing God. The Omnipotent Father, The Great I AM. The Elohim! Faith is the force that activates the endless possibilities in God. By faith the elders obtained a good report (Hebrews 11:2). Without

faith , it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:3). He will respond to our diligent search for Him and reward our faith with dumb-founding miracles and testimonies. However, faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. We need to know the Word of God, absolutely believe in the word and activate our faith through belief in the word! It starts with knowing the promises of God in His word! If we must see God's hand move in our situations, we must be ready to diligently seek Him through His word! W4KG!

- *Stability in the Midst of Uncertainty.*

For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless, I am not ashamed for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day. 2 Timothy 1:12 KJV .

Paul found strength to persevere in his calling despite the challenges because he knew God and was convinced that God would bring him to an expected end.

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:58.

Our knowledge of God will help us to keep moving, our challenges not withstanding. David said, even though he was walking through the valley of the shadow of death, he feared no evil, because he was convinced that God was with him. There is strength in knowing God!! W4KG!



Why We Must Know God



- *To be fruitful in Every Good Work*

But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in His law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. Psalm 1:2-3 KJV

Delight in God's Word, meditation on His word, will lead to fruitfulness. Without Him we can do nothing. We will bear much fruit if we stay in Him. Increasing in the knowledge of God means increasing in our fruitfulness; fruitfulness in ministry, career, family life, etc.

- *Strength for Exploits*

But the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits. Daniel 11:32b KJV

An exploit is a bold or daring feat. It can also be defined as a heroic act or an act worthy of praise. The scripture says that exploits are the reserve of those who know their God. The fathers of the faith did many exploits.

Moses led 2 million people through the wilderness. He divided the red sea for them to walk on dry land. They were fed with rations that were supernaturally provided. Daniel survived the threat of attack by hungry lions, the three Hebrew boys survived the violence of fire, Abraham received the child of promise in an old age, Isaac sowed in a land of famine and reaped a good harvest, and Joseph ruled in a strange land and fed the whole world during his tenure. All these people were able to do all these exploits by virtue of the fact that

THEY KNEW GOD! The people who know their God shall be strong and do exploits! It's time for us to do exploits for God in our ministries, families, workplaces, in our nations and on our continents! W4KG!

- *Holiness and Consecration.*

You will most likely become like the one you spend most of your time with. The aura of the ones you move with will definitely rubs off you. God is holy, and He calls us to be holy. Holiness and consecration are keys to elevation in the kingdom.

Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. Hebrews 1:9 KJV

We can only experience God's fullness if we consecrate ourselves. Knowing and fearing God leads to a consecrated life. W4KG!

- *To secure our Blessed Hope of Being Brought to an Expected End.*

Out of the 2 Million people who were freed from Egypt, only 2 reached the promised land; Joshua and Caleb. They came back with a good report from spying the land, contrary to the other 10 who came announcing doom and gloom. Even though Joshua and Caleb experienced the same things as the other 10, they decided to hang their report on what they knew about what God had said. Their application of the knowledge of God in this situation separated them from the rest of the crowd. They said;

And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. If the LORD delight in us, then He will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which floweth with milk and honey. Only rebel not ye against the LORD, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and the LORD is with us: fear them not. Numbers 14:7-9 KJV

God was pleased with Joshua and Caleb and He blessed them.

But My servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed Me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it. Numbers 14:24

Caleb and Joshua secured access to the promised land through the knowledge of God. God said of Caleb, that he had followed Him fully! You will end up in the destination of the person you decide to follow!!!

Jesus has promised us an eternal Land in His Glory. Let us seek to know Him and to follow Him and end up with Him in His Glory when He appears! Heaven ! W4KG!!!



The Holy Spirit and The Knowledge of God

*Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. **2 Peter 1:21-22 KJV***

*But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. **John 14:26 KJV***

*Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: **John 16:13a KJV***

These scriptures vividly describe the mandate of the Holy Spirit to help believers know God. What better opportunity can one have to understand a book than having its author explain the intent behind each word, phrase and literary device employed?

The Holy Spirit will guide us into the truths about God without any ambiguities. He will teach us all we need to know about Him. The sons of God will be led by the Spirit of God to know Him.

*For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. **Romans 8:14 KJV***

Some believers complain about their lack of understanding of certain portions of scripture and

certain kingdom concepts. This will be a thing of the past for you!. The manifestations of the Holy Spirit include knowledge and understanding!

*And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD. **Isaiah 11:2 KJV***

The Holy Spirit will make us of quick understanding in the fear of the Lord. We shall know the Lord as He, the Holy Spirit, teaches us the Truth about Him.

This implies that we need intimacy and fellowship with the Spirit of God to be able to know God. We must cultivate our relationship with the Spirit through consecration, waiting in His Presence, meditation on Scripture, and quick obedience to His leadings and promptings.

The Holy Spirit has the most tremendous teaching ministry of all time. He authored the Bible and He will help us to rightly divide the word of truth! He will teach us the Father and help us to know the Father!



A Lesson From Moses The Prophet

Moses is one of the Greatest Prophets that ever lived.

There has never again been a prophet in Israel like Moses. The LORD spoke face to face with him and sent him to perform powerful miracles in the presence of the king of Egypt and his entire nation. No one else has ever had the power to do such great things as Moses did for everyone to see. Deuteronomy 34:10-12 CEV

Unlike other Prophets who God speaks to through visions and other “indirect” ways, He spoke to Moses, mouth to mouth. God called him a faithful servant .

And He said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make Myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream. My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all Mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against My servant Moses? Numbers 12:6-8

Moses knew God. He knew how to even intercede for God to change His mind from destroying His own people when they had sinned against Him. But Moses was always seeking a closer walk and a

deeper knowledge of a God who spoke to him face to face! What could be beyond that? Yet he pressed for more! God spoke to him as one speaks to His friend and yet he was not satisfied.

And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend Exodus 33:11 KJV

One day he asked God to show Him His Glory. He wanted to see the fullness of God! God said it was not possible, because no one can see His face and live.

And he said, I beseech thee, shew me Thy glory Exodus 33:18 KJV.

God made him a deal and showed him His back.

And I will take away mine hand, and thou shalt see my back parts: but my face shall not be seen. Exodus 33:18 KJV.

Moses teaches us that there are depths in God and that we should not be satisfied with what we think we know of Him. He also teaches us to seek Him and ask Him to reveal Himself to us as He surely will. He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. It is time to increase in the knowledge of God. W4KG!!!

A Note from David The King



David is known in scripture as a man after God's own heart.

...To whom He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will. Acts 13:22

He was a God-lover. He was also hungry to be in God's presence. He was an adorer and an avid reader of the word. He loved the word. He described God's word as sweeter than the honeycomb. He always longed to spent time with God.

As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God? Psalm 42:1-2 KJV.

A Fascinating Story About Sir Isaac Newton

Say the name Sir Isaac Newton and what comes to mind is gravity, calculus and differential equations. But few know about the other side of Newton which I myself only discovered recently. A dear friend shared a book titled *"Observations Upon the Prophecies of Daniel, and the Apocalypse of St. John"* written by Sir Newton which I decided to read out of curiosity.

In the book I talk of, at least, I do find this relationship I speak of at play.

In the book, Sir Newton studiously expounds on the hard topics of end-time prophecies sealed up in the books of Daniel and St. John's Apocalypse.
